

Medication Policy

We can only give medication to your child with prior written notice. Permission to administer long-term medication can be given when we fill out the contract. If your child needs a short course of medication you will be asked to complete the necessary documentation before any medication can be administered.

Non-prescribed medication

(E.g. cough mixture, Calpol, teething gel etc). Please label with your child's name.

Prescribed medication

Must be in the original container with the dispensing label attached. Please note that medicines containing aspirin will only be given if prescribed by a doctor.

We will ensure that all medication given to us will be stored correctly and we will check that it is still within its expiry date,

If your child has a self-held medication please obtain an additional one for us to be kept here. Older children can easily forget to bring home an inhaler.

If your child has acute allergies and carries/needs an epi-pen, please discuss the matter with us. We may need additional training to administer these forms of medication.

We will record all medication administered and request a parental signature at the end of each day.

If you have any concerns regarding medication please do not hesitate to discuss them with us.
